Changes to stationary fees for 2018 We have just gone live with new accounting software so you will all be receiving your invoices via email this year & monthly statements. We may have some teething problems so please bare with us & let Celeste know if something does not look right on your school account. You should receive invoices first then a statement of each school account. Please note some of you have credit balances being transferred over from 2017 & this will show up on your monthly statement. Just a reminder that our stationery fees have been reduced for 2018, a schedule of costs is as follows:

- ❑ Year 1&2 - Tamure - **Stationery \$60 per year**
- ❑ Year 2&3 - Kahawai - **Stationery \$60 per year**
- ❑ Year 3&4 - Whai - **Stationery \$60 per year**
- ❑ Year 5&6 - Haku - those with **Chromebooks \$65 per year for Stationery**
Year 5&6 - Haku - those without **Chromebooks \$75 per year for Stationery**
- ❑ Year 7&8 - Mango - those with **Chromebooks \$65 per year for Stationery**
Year 7&8 - Mango- those without **Chromebooks \$75 per year fo Stationery**
Year 7&8 - Mango - **Technology Fees \$60 per year**
- ❑ **Raglan Taxi Bus Users** - your confirmation sent out at the beginning of the term specifies your child's fees for Term 1 bus.
- ❑ Te Mata School **Bucket Hat \$15**
- ❑ Te Mata **T Shirt \$20**
- ❑ **Swimming Pool Key \$60** per season (keys due back end of Term 1)

Please note - the School does not have EFTPOS facilities, we will happily accept cash and cheques in the school office or you can pay via direct credit.

Bus Messages If you have an afternoon bus message please call the school by 2.30pm and **dial 1 to leave a bus message**. Please do not send emails as we get busy and don't always get them in time. Thank you for your understanding.

Picking up your child If your child usually catches the bus home and you come to school to collect them, could you please let the Teacher on bus duty that you are taking your child. This makes it difficult to load up buses when we are trying to locate children that have already been picked up. We don't want to leave anyone behind either!
