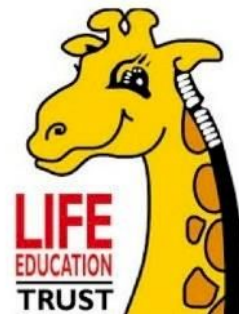

YEAR 7 Immunisation

The Year 7 immunisation for Diphtheria, Tetanus and Whooping Cough will be undertaken this term. Consent forms will be sent home with EVERY year 7 student. Please complete and return to the school office. There is provision within the form for your non-consent, should you wish for that.

PLEASE REMEMBER- WE WOULD LIKE ALL FORMS RETURNED REGARDLESS IF THEY ARE FOR CONSENT OR NON-CONSENT. As part of the programme, information will be given to each year 7 student. If you do not want your child to receive this education and/or to view the presentation the Public Health Nurse uses, then send a letter to the office so that your child can be removed from that class presentation on the day of the education session.

YEAR 8 Immunisation

The year 8 immunisation for HPV (Human Papillomavirus) which can develop into cervical cancer and other HPV related cancers, will be undertaken in two doses within the year. Consent forms will be sent home with all year 8 students. Please complete and return to the school office. There is provision within the form for your non-consent, should you wish for that.

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BREAKFAST IDEAS

EASY OMELETTE

Team Energie

- 2 large eggs
- 2 Tbsp. water
- Pinch of salt and pepper
- 1 Tbsp. low fat spread
- ½ cup filling – eg cheese, tomato, capsicum or your favourite vegetables

In a bowl mix eggs, water, salt and pepper well. Melt spread on medium heat in a medium sized pan. Pour in egg mix covering whole pan. Using a spatula, pull in cooked egg from the outside. Tilt the pan so uncooked egg can fill gaps until the bottom is set and egg looks slightly wet on top. Add fillings on one half of omelette and then gently fold other half on top. Slip on to a plate and enjoy!
