What an amazing week to be part of Te Mata School! Our cross-country saw true dedication from all students who put in their best efforts and showed encouragement to everyone.

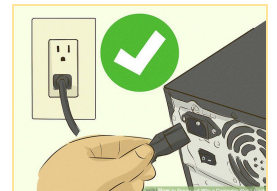
The Passion Learning programs commenced and children had the opportunity to take part in a range of activities. Thank you those parents who have volunteered their time to help us.

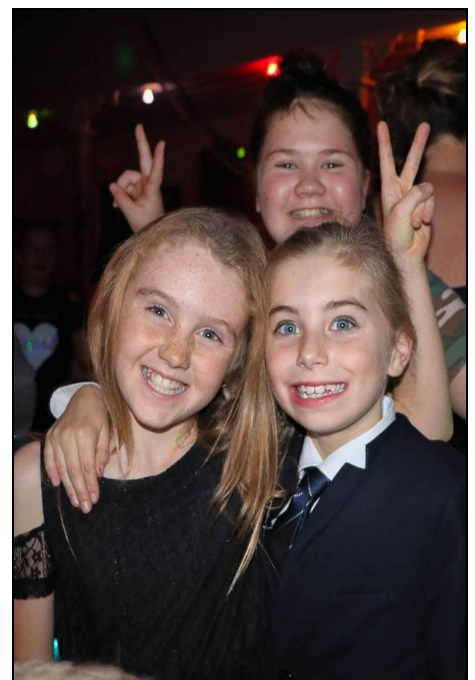
